

SUSPICIOUS PERSON / POSSIBLE FRAUDULENT ACTIVITY

On 02-07-2008, the King County Sheriff's Office Major Crimes Unit (Det. Jon Holland) was notified about a suspicious person using the name of Christopher Heath. Heath had been contacting agents as a potential client. The contacts were somewhat similar to the contacts made in the unsolved Mike Emert homicide investigation.

Occupation: Was possibly a licensed EMT at one time in Florida. (The Fire Academy has no record of him being a potential employee)

Current whereabouts: Heath is currently a transient. He is more than likely staying in the area of the New York University Medical Center. Heath used the number of 212-263-7000 to contact agents. This number belongs to Dr. James Wittig of the NYU Medical Center.

Marital status: The phone number of 802-223-1648 belongs to Pam Cameron in Vermont. Cameron was married to Heath for a short period of time. Cameron is the primary source of information on Heath. She states that Heath is a con artist and a transient type drifter with no legitimate sources of income. She states that Heath has more than likely been to the Seattle area. Detectives will attempt to determine if he was in our area at the time of Emert's death.

Criminal History: Heath has five arrests in the state of Florida from 1998 – 2007. All of the arrests are fraud related.
